While financial challenges persist for those we serve, our community's families are resiliently navigating the enduring effects of the pandemic and rising costs. The strength of a supportive community remains truly remarkable. The demand for our services has surged significantly, with the first ten months of 2023 showing a remarkable 136% increase in the number of individuals served compared to the entire twelve months of 2022.

In the past year we expanded operations to now include the following programs:

- Homelessness Prevention Program
- Rural & Suburban Outreach & Engagement Program
- Comprehensive Eviction Defense & Diversion Program
- Homelessness Diversion Program
- Homelessness Prevention & Rapid Re-Housing Program 2
- FEMA Emergency Food & Shelter Program
- American Rescue Plan for Homeless Children & Youth Program



Thanks to the dedication and expertise of our team, here's what we've achieved in the past year:

- Provided re-housing services to 106 homeless individuals, including 61 adults and 45 children.
- Prevented homelessness for 453 individuals, including 294 adults and 159 children.
- Assisted a total of 253 households through prevention, re-housing, and rapid resolution programs.
- Offered daily support and linkages to those in need of essential services.
